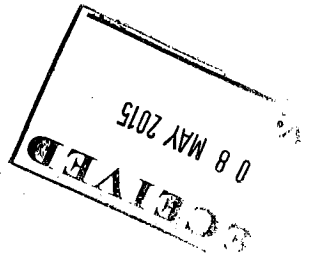

Dear Preliminary Committee Members

Thank you for your letters dated 7 April 2015 regarding the formation of the Western Australian Moorings Association (WAMA) and the mooring regulation stream line review. The Director General has noted your request and requested I respond on their behalf.

The Department of Transport, (DoT) welcomes input from all stakeholders when undertaking such reviews and welcomes the formation of WAMA. Should WAMA be approved by the Department of Commerce as an incorporated body that represents the interests of all mooring registration and license holders, the DoT will formally extend an invite to nominate one representative and one proxy to be included in the key stakeholder working groups during the course of the review. Please note the next meeting is scheduled for June.

The first of a two stage consultation process is due to be completed on 8 May 2015 and a summary report of this consultation stage will be available on the DoT website at the following link. <http://www.transport.wa.gov.au/marine/mooring-regulation-streamline-review.asp> Further updates on the progress of the review will also be available as they come to hand on the DoT webpage.

The DoT is required under the *Mooring Regulations 1998* to maintain a register of mooring licences and mooring sites. This register is maintained and in accordance with *Section 8 (4)* of the *Mooring Regulations 1998* members of the public may view the register free of charge during business hours. This register contains the number of every registered mooring site and the name of the licensee; however it will not provide the contact details of the licensee. Under the Freedom of Information Act personal information such as contact details cannot be released.
