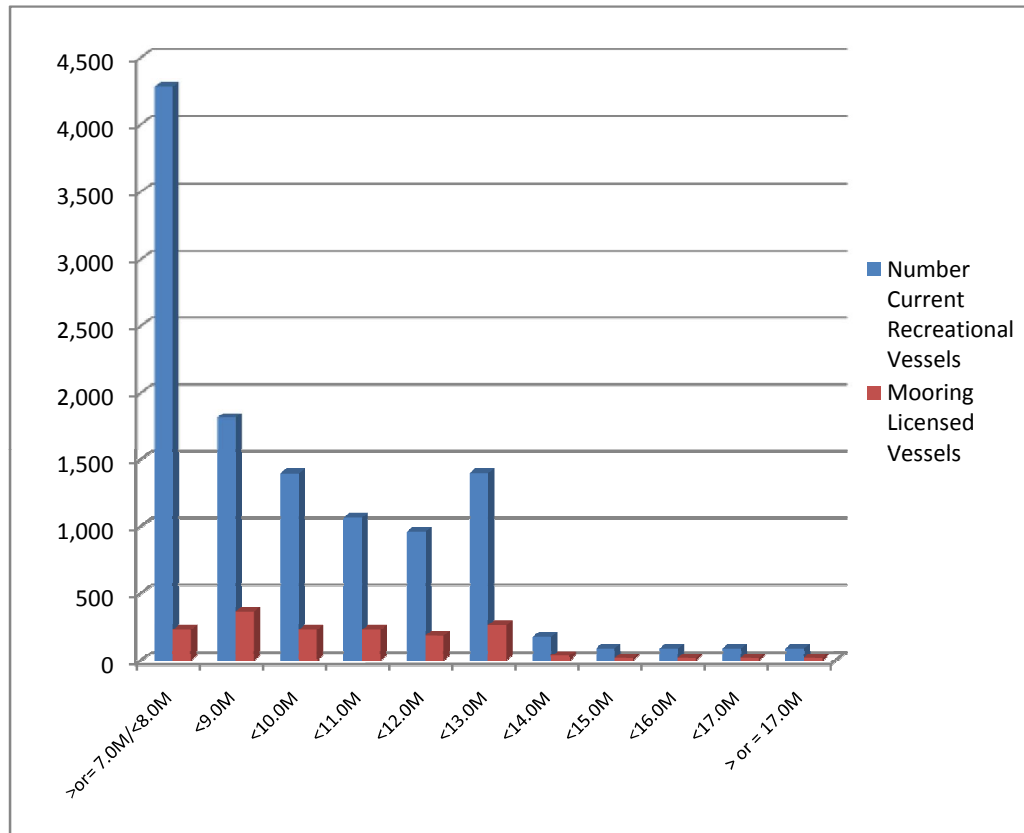

for vessels below 7.0 M are so low the figures are meaningless to this chart

NOTE 1: Of the DoT's 97,000 or so recreational vessels it is probable about 56,000 (or those less than 5.0 Metres) may be too short for a Mooring Site Licence under the Mooring Regulations 1998. (See MR1998 r.10 (3))

NOTE 2: A more accurate analysis of mooring swings could be undertaken with mooring statistics requested from the DoT by WAMA.

NOTE 3: The WAMA mooring swing analysis was undertaken with quite a large data base.
